Tulips are erect flowers with long, broad, parallel-veined leaves and cup shape, single or double flowers at the tip of the stem. Their colours can range from red to yellow to white. Several tulips are vari-coloured as a result of a viral disease carried and transferred to the plants by aphids.

In northern climate, tulips bulbs are planted before the ground freezes, usually between September and December. In warmer climates, they are treated annually. Tulips can grow in climate zones 2-7. They are usually planted twice as deep as their heights and about three to four inches apart. Tulip bulbs can be planted in all types of soil as long as there is good drainage. Tulips need to be watered thoroughly and may need to be covered with leaves or compost during periods of severe frost. Tulips can make a colorful addition to any flower bed or garden and are very easy to grow.

Grasshoppers are insects of the order Orthoptera, suborder Caelifera. They are typically ground-dwelling insects with powerful hind legs which enable them to escape from threats by leaping vigorously. At high population densities and under certain environmental conditions, some grasshopper species can change colour and behaviour and form swarms. Under these circumstances they are known as locusts.

Grasshoppers are plant-eaters, sometimes becoming serious pests of cereals, vegetables and pasture, especially when they swarm in their millions as locusts and destroy crops over wide areas. They protect themselves from predators by camouflage; when detected, many species attempt to startle the predator with a brilliantly-coloured wing-flash while jumping and (if adult) launching themselves into the air, usually flying for only a short distance.

A large grasshopper such as a locust can jump about a metre (twenty body lengths) without using its wings; the acceleration peaks at about 20 g. Grasshoppers jump by extending their large back legs and pushing against the substrate (the ground, a twig, a blade of grass or whatever else they are standing on). They jump for several reasons; to escape from a predator, to launch themselves for flight, or simply to move from place to place. Grasshoppers lay their eggs in pods in the ground near food plants, generally in the summer. After a few weeks of development, the eggs of most species go into diapause, and pass the winter in this state; in a few species the eggs hatch in the same summer they were laid.

In some countries, grasshoppers are used as food. In southern Mexico, grasshoppers, known as *chapulines*, are eaten in a variety of dishes, such as in tortillas with chilli sauce. Grasshoppers are served on skewers in some Chinese food markets, like the Donghuamen Night Market. Fried grasshoppers (*walanggoreng*) are eaten in the GunungKidul area of Yogyakarta, Java in Indonesia.

Disneyland was the brilliant and creative idea of Walt Disney, an American film producer, cartoonist, animator and voice actor responsible for the creation of characters such as Mickey Mouse, Goofy and Donald Duck and a great many classic movies. Disneyland opened on July 17th, 1955, the first of two theme parks in Anaheim, California opened by Walt Disney, who built Disneyland after being inspired following visits to different parks with his daughters.

Walt Disney had the idea of the park for many years before it was built. He dreamed of the park being built on eight acres beside Burbank Studios in California. World War II put those plans on hold. Cristiano Ronaldo was born on February 5, 1985, in Funchal, Madeira, Portugal. Manchester United paid £12 million to sign him in 2003 - a record fee for a player of his age. In the 2004 FA Cup Final, he scored Manchester's first three goals and helped them capture the championship. In 2008, he set a franchise record for goals scored. In 2009, Real Madrid paid a record \$131 million for his service.

It was through his dad's work as an equipment manager at a boy's club that Ronaldo was first introduced to the game of soccer. By the time he was 10 years old, he was already recognized as a phenomenon - a kid who ate, slept and drank the game. "All he wanted to do as a boy was playing football," his godfather, Fernao Sousa, recalled for British reporters, adding, "He loved the game so much that he'd miss meals or escape out his bedroom window with a ball when he was supposed to be doing his homework."

By his early teens, Ronaldo's talent and legend had grown considerably. After a stint with Nacional da liha da Madeira, he signed with Sporting Portugal in 2001. That same year, at the tender age of 16, Ronaldo turned heads with a impressive performance against Manchester United, wowing even his opponents with his footwork and deft skill. He made such an impression that a number of United players asked their manager to try and sign the young player. It wasn't long before the club paid Ronaldo's team more than £12 million for his services - a record fee for a player of his age.
